## **Suggested Scoring Guidance**

- A fully-developed response demonstrates a clear understanding of the criterion requirements. The response not only addresses the factor, but also *comprehensively* demonstrates alignment between what is proposed, how it will be carried out, and the subsequent impact.
- A well-developed response demonstrates a clear understanding of the criterion requirements. The response addresses the factor and demonstrates a basic alignment between what is proposed and how it will be carried out and the subsequent impact.
- An adequate response demonstrates a partial understanding of the criterion requirements. The response may address the factor, but provides inadequate, and at times, inconsistent information with regard to what is proposed, how it will be carried out, and the subsequent impact.
- A poorly-developed response demonstrates minimal understanding of the criterion requirements. The response does not address the factor, and demonstrates poor alignment between what is proposed, how it will be carried out, and the subsequent impact.
- A zero-point response means that the criterion requirements were not addressed anywhere in the application.
