Pre-Award

- Design clear evaluation methods for your grant application
- Consider existing campus data, research, and evaluation systems
- Consider tools or software currently available on campus
- Develop optimistic, yet attainable evidence-based objectives
- Gather quantifiable baselines for project objectives

Pre-Award

- Design formative and summative evaluation methods
- Select quantitative and qualitative data elements
- Consider method for external evaluation
- Create time-line for evaluation processes
- Align with other campus strategic plans

Project Implementation

- Create project steering committee
- Stick to evaluation timelines
- Communicate established objectives, baselines, and goals
- Integrate into existing institutional program review or planning and assessment strategies

Project Implementation

▶ 3 levels of assessment and evaluation

- Activity or strategy
- Project
- Institutional

Activity or strategy

- Tracking systems, lab check-in's, etc...
- Internal progress reports by departments or activities
- Staff time and effort reports
- Surveys

Project Implementation

Project

- Project goals and objectives
- Monthly progress reports to Program Office
- ▶ IPR, APR, and FPR
- External Evaluation
- Reports and presentations to college community

Project Implementation

Institutional

- Comparisons to college goals
- Impacts on completion, transfer, retention, success, etc...
- College-wide surveys such as CCSSE and SENSE

External Evaluation

Provides technical support

- Evaluates progress of project
- Provides compliance support
- Identifies project opportunities
- Assesses project budget
- Clarifies purpose of project
- Reviews project assessment
