



## U.S. Projected 9-12 Public Grades Enrollment in Millions






## **US Census Regions**






## Projected Hispanic Enrollment By Public Elementary and Secondary Schools by Regions From 2018 To 2027









## Enrollment Patterns in Public Elementary and Secondary Schools in Millions




## HSIs: Past, Current, & Projected






## Enrollment Patterns in Higher Education in Millions



## **Overview**

- A one-year program to prepare the next generation of culturally diverse leaders for the ranks of executive and senior-level positions at higher education institutions.
- A direct response to the declining rate of Hispanic university presidents (from 4.5 percent in 2006 to 3.9 percent in 2016), despite the unprecedented growth of U.S. Hispanic college student enrollment.



## **Elements of the Program**

- Three week-long face-to-face seminars integrated with HACU's highly regarded Annual Conference, Capitol Forum, and International Conference/Experience outside the U.S.
- A curriculum that emphasizes Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs) and Emerging HSIs, but with a holistic approach, including the search process, leadership fundamentals, current critical issues, and international relations.



## **Elements of the Program**

- Hybrid content delivery with both in-person sessions and synchronous and asynchronous webinars that allow a high degree of flexibility for busy work schedules.
- More than a dozen nationally and internationally recognized current and emeriti presidents and seniorlevel administrators with 100 plus years of combined experience serving on the faculty and/or as mentors.
- Development and implementation of a project designed to enhance the quality of services provided at the institution with which the Fellow is affiliated and that may have application at other institutions.

## **Application Process**

- Applications due March 6, 2020; however, we will accept application through the end of March
- Fellows notified of acceptance by April 17, 2020
- Who should apply?
- Give yourself enough time to complete the application
  - Requires two letters of recommendation
  - Complete the application offline prior to submission
